NOTEBOOK

• Charlotte has been to the NCAA Tournament six of the last eight years. Last season, head coach **Bobby Lutz** led the 49ers to their fourth NCAA Tournament in his six years as head coach. His four NCAA appearances are a Charlotte record, topping Jeff Mullins' three trips.

• Junior forward **Curtis Withers** led C-USA with 16 double-doubles last year (4th in the NCAA). A first team All-C-USA choice, Withers was named a Third Team All-America honoree by *Basketball Times*. The last time the 49ers returned a first-team All-C-USA player, he went on to become the league's Player of the Year (DeMarco Johnson, 1988).

• Withers earned a spot on the prestigious Wooden Award Watch List. He also had a productive summer, winning a gold medal as a starter for USA Basketball's World Championship for Young Men Qualifying Tournament.

• Senior **Eddie Basden** was named the 2004 C-USA Defensive Player of the Year. He became the first 49er in school history to post back-to-back 60-steal seasons. In addition, he averaged double figures in scoring (10.4 ppg), was second on the team in rebounds and assists and shot .536 from the field.

• The 49ers led C-USA in both scoring (79.1 ppg) and rebounding (40.7 rpg) last year.

• Charlotte set a school record with 10 true road wins and scored three wins over Top 10 teams (at then-No. 7 Syracuse; at then-No. 8 Cincinnati and vs. then-No. 9 Louisville).

• **Jason Maxiell** begins his senior season with 1,060 career points, ranking him 35th on Cincinnati's career scoring list. Maxiell is second in all-time blocks with 161. The career record is 292 set by Kenyon Martin (1996-00). On the C-USA career charts, Maxiell ranks 50th in scoring and seventh in blocked shots.

• **Bob Huggins'** 13-straight NCAA appearances at UC is the third-longest active streak among Division I head coaches. Only Lute Olson (20) of Arizona and Roy Williams (14) of North Carolina (and formerly Kansas) have had more teams in the NCAA Tournament.

• Cincinnati enjoyed its eighth 25-win season in the last nine years in 2003-04, and the 10th during Bob Huggins' tenure at UC.

• Cincinnati is 205-27 in 15 seasons (.884) in Fifth Third Arena at Shoemaker Center. UC is 41-4 in the Shoe over the last three seasons and 66-6 versus Conference USA teams over the past nine years.

• Cincinnati teams have earned a reputation for their defense and rebounding emphasis under Huggins, and the success of last year's team is evidence of that. UC held its foes to a .374 field goal percentage, second in the NCAA team statistics. The Bearcats were eighth in points allowed, surrendering 60.4 per game. Cincinnati was No. 2 in average scoring margin (+17.8 points) and No. 18 in rebounding margin (+5.9). The Bearcats were also successful at taking care of the ball, their 11.9 turnover average ranked 11th nationally.

- **Drake Diener** enters his final season at DePaul tied for the school record for career free throw percentage (.853) and also ranks fourth in three-point field goals (131), and sixth in both three-point field goals attempted (342) and three-point field goal percentage (.383).

- Diener needs 33 three-point field goals to become the school's all-time leader and is now one of three players in DePaul history to have 130 three-point field goals and 200 assists in a career (Brandon Cole and Peter Patton are the others).

- Last season, **Sammy Mejia** was the only player in C-USA to record a double-figure scoring game, a double-figure rebounding game and a double-figure assist game.

- Mejia became one of four DePaul players to hand out 100 assists in their freshman campaign and his 140 assists was the 16th-best single-season performance in school history and the third-best by a freshman.

- DePaul's 22 wins last season were the most by a Blue Demon team since the 1987-88 squad also won 22. DePaul also won the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 1989 with an opening round victory over Dayton.
