NOTEBOOK

• Senior **Moussa Badiane** needs to block 54 shots to become the all-time leader in blocked shots in Conference USA history. He enters the season with 239 career blocks, 53 shy of the record held by Kenyon Martin.

• **Bill Herrion** begins his sixth season as the Pirates' head coach, making him the longest tenured coach at ECU since Tom Quinn coached the team from 1966-74 (eight seasons).

• East Carolina will have one of the youngest teams in Conference USA with only one senior, Badiane, and one returning junior, **Corey Rouse**, on its roster.

• The Pirates have had at least one player named to the Conference USA All-Freshman in two of its first three seasons in the league: Badiane (2002) and **Mike Cook** (2004). East Carolina has signed six incoming freshmen for the 2004-05 season.

• C-USA basketball fans will readily recognize the name of one the Pirates' six newcomers. **Tom Hammonds, Jr.**, the son of former Georgia Tech All-American and NBA standout Tom Hammonds, will join East Carolina this fall. Hammonds, Jr., averaged 11.6 points per game in helping Montrose Christian School (Md.) to a 25-7 record and a National Association of Christian Schools championship.

NOTEBOOK

- Senior guard **Andre Owens** is Houston's top returning player. Owens has started every game over the last two seasons and enters the 2004-05 campaign having made 54 consecutive starts. He was also the team's leading scorer with 16.0 points per game in 2003-04. Last year, Owens became the first Cougar to score 40 points in a game since the 1986-87 season when he netted 41 in an overtime win over Texas A&M. He needs to score 40 more points to reach the 1,000-point plateau in his college career. Owens needs 178 points to surpass the 1,000-mark at Houston, playing his freshman season at Indiana.

- Among the nine juniors are five junior college transfers who signed with the Cougars after Tom Penders was named head coach. They are **Englebert Cherrington**, **Brian Latham**, **Chris Lawson**, **Rodney Hannah** and **Sergio de Randamie**. Cherrington, Latham and de Randamie were teammates at Midland College in Midland, Texas, where they played for new associate head coach Shanon Hays. Lawson comes to Houston from Southwest Los Angeles College, while Hannah signed with the Cougars after playing at Yuba College in Marysville, Calif.

- **Englebert Cherrington** is from Belize City, Belize, and is the first Cougar to hail from a Central American country. His UH teammate, **Sergio de Randamie**, hails from Suriname and is the first South American player for Houston since Rafael Carrasco (Bogota, Colombia) suited up for the Cougars from 1990-94 and the ninth overall South American player since 1986-87.

NOTEBOOK

• The Cardinals welcome back forward **Ellis Myles** for his senior season. Myles, who missed all of last season while rehabilitating a knee injury suffered late in his junior year, averaged 7.8 points and 7.9 rebounds during the 2002-03 season.

• U of L forward **Francisco Garcia** will open his junior year just 182 points short of becoming the Cardinals' 54th career 1,000-point scorer. Only North Carolina (55) has more 1,000-point scorers than Louisville. With 818 career points, Garcia is only the 15th player in Louisville history to score at least 800 points in their initial two years with the Cardinals, and is the first since DeJuan Wheat scored 973 in his first two years at Louisville in 1995-97.

• Louisville ranks among the nation's elite programs in terms of NCAA Tournament appearances. Only five teams -- Kentucky (45), UCLA (36), North Carolina (36), Kansas (33) and Indiana (32) -- have more NCAA Tournament appearances than U of L's 31.

• U of L ranked among the top 30 nationally in six statistical categories in NCAA statistics last season, including field goal percentage defense (2nd in the nation, .382), scoring margin (10th, +11.6), free throw percentage (14th, 74.9), blocked shots per game (18th, 5.1), scoring defense (22nd, 61.5), and three-point field goals per game (27th, 8.0). Individually, **Larry O'Bannon** was 30th in free throw percentage (.860).
