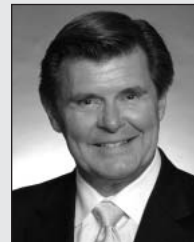

NOTEBOOK

• **Brad Soderberg** became the third Billiken head coach to guide SLU into the postseason in his first two seasons, joining Eddie Hickey (1948 and 1949 NIT) and John Benington (1959 and 1960 NIT). He is the first Saint Louis coach to lead his club into the C-USA Tournament semifinals in back-to-back years.

• Saint Louis has led C-USA in scoring defense in each of the past two seasons. Last year, the Billikens improved their scoring defense from 60.7 ppg (17th NCAA) during the 2002-03 campaign to 59.9 ppg this past year (13th NCAA). SLU's scoring defense is the second-best in C-USA history behind the 1996-97 Marquette squad which allowed 57.8 points per contest.

• SLU center **Tom Frericks** is Conference USA's top returning percentage shooter after connecting on 57.4 percent of his attempts from the floor last season. His mark ties for seventh in Billiken annals and fourth among SLU players during their junior campaign.

• Last year's 9-7 conference mark was the fourth consecutive year that Saint Louis has posted a .500 or better record in league play. SLU is one of six C-USA teams to boast such a feat.
