NOTEBOOK

• Southern Miss enters the 2004-05 season under the direction of **Larry Eustachy**, the 18th head men's basketball coach in school history. Eustachy, who replaces James Green, begins his 14th season as a head coach on the Division I level and has a career-record of 260-145.

• In his three Division I coaching stints, Eustachy has seen tremendous success, advancing to the NCAA Tournament three times and the NIT Tournament twice. Eustachy also has been named a conference Coach of the Year four times, twice each with the Big West and the Big 12.

• Senior guard **Dante Stiggers** currently ranks seventh all-time in assists with 334. He is also just 66 assists away from 400, a number that would put him in second place in school history, behind Casey Fisher's all-time mark of 612. Stiggers also has 101 career steals and needs 25 to break into the top 10 of that category.

• Senior guard **David Haywood** ranks among the school's all-time best in three-point shooting. He has 85 career three-pointers, 11th all-time, and is second overall in three-point field goal percentage with a .421 career mark.

• TCU returns four of its five starters from last year and also brings back 86.9 percent of its offense and 88.9 percent of its rebounding. Back for the Horned Frogs are leading scorer, senior guard **Corey Santee** (14.5 ppg), and leading rebounder, junior **Chudi Chinweze** (4.9 rpg).

• **Corey Santee**, a 2003 Third Team All-Conference USA selection, starts the season in eighth place on the school's all-time scoring list and fourth in career assists. He currently ranks fifth all-time in C-USA with 448 assists and is the league's active scoring leader with 1,331 points.

• **Marcus Shropshire**, who averaged 13.1 ppg, emerged as TCU's long-range threat last season, connecting on a team-best 76 treys (6th C-USA) during the season. His three-point total ties for fifth place on the TCU single-season chart.

• TCU's seven league victories (7-9 C-USA) in 2004 were the most since the school joined Conference USA in 2001-02 when it posted six wins.

NOTEBOOK

• Point guard **Marcus Kinzer**, who will be a senior in 2004-05, was one of four players in Conference USA to average more than 10.0 points, 3.0 assists and 3.5 rebounds per game last season.

• Returning to the Green Wave lineup for 2004-05 will be seven-footer **Ivan Pjevcevic** who red-shirted the 2003-04 season after injuring his knee eight minutes into the season-opener. He is Tulane's all-time leader in three-point percentage at .439 (50-114).

• Tulane's top three returning scorers - **Quincy Davis, Kinzer** and **Vytas Tatarunas** - raised their scoring averages by a combined 20.4 points per game last year, boosting their point totals from 182 in 2002-03 to 841 last season.

• Davis set the single-season school record for blocks by swatting 67 shots as a sophomore. He now has 78 career blocks and needs 114 more to catch John "Hot Rod" Williams for the all-time Tulane lead.

• Tulane's sophomore class returns this season with a wealth of experience after playing the most minutes of any freshman class in Conference USA last season. As Wave newcomers last year, they registered 1,620 minutes of playing time, the most of any freshmen class in 2003-04.
