## NOTEBOOK

- For just the third time in school history, and first time since 1994, UAB concluded the season ranked in the USA Today/ESPN final poll. The Blazers, finished ranked 23rd in the nation according to the poll, marking the first time since USA Today began doing a post-tournament poll that the Blazers are ranked. UAB finished the 1982 campaign with a ranking of 17th in the nation according to the Associated Press and ended the 1994 regular season ranked 23rd in the nation according to the USA Today poll, before falling out of the rankings in the first post-tournament poll ever.

- Entering his third year as head coach at UAB, **Mike Anderson** is 43-23 (.652) overall and 20-12 (.625) in C-USA contests. On March 21, he guided the Blazers to one of their most memorable wins when UAB defeated top-seeded Kentucky, 76-75, to earn the program's first Sweet 16 appearance since the 1982 campaign. Anderson was honored as the 2004 Ray Meyer Conference USA Coach of the Year. In 2002-03, he was one of only three first-year coaches nationally to win 20 games.

- With its stunning 76-75 second-round upset of top-seeded Kentucky in last year's NCAA Tournament (March 21), UAB advanced to the Sweet 16 for only the third time in school history and the first time since 1982. The Blazers became just the third ninth seed to advance to the Sweet 16 since 1985.

**NOTEBOOK**

• USF returns three starters from last season including senior forward **Terrence Leather**, and senior guards **Bradley Mosley** and **Brian Swift**. Leather, Mosley and Swift were USF's top three scorers a year ago. The trio accounted for 64 percent of the Bulls' scoring and 37 percent of the team's rebounding last year.

• Leather was 10th among C-USA leaders with 15.5 ppg while Mosley was 12th with 14.6 ppg. Swift ended the 2003-04 season a bucket shy of a double-digit scoring average at 9.9 ppg. USF was led in scoring by one of the three players in 25 of last season's 27 games.

• Seniors **Brandon Brigman** and **Marlyn Bryant** are among the eight returning lettermen for USF in 2004-05. The duo made a combined nine starts due to injuries last season.

• Head coach **Robert McCullum** enters his second season at USF after a 7-20 inaugural campaign that included a 1-15 C-USA mark. The Bulls will be working toward a turnaround similar to the one McCullum orchestrated at his first head-coaching stop at Western Michigan. His first Bronco club was 7-21 in 2000-01 while year two saw a 10-win improvement to 17-13 in 2001-02. McCullum led WMU to a 20-11 mark and an NIT bid in 2002-03.
